<p>Instructions</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Application deadline: 11:59 pm, Sunday, January 4, 2026.• Include a link to an unedited video of your performance, no more than 12 minutes in length. See note on restricted repertory. <p>The piece may be a part of a larger work (for example, a movement from a multi movement concerto), or it may be a couple of smaller works (for example 2 or 3 arias).</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Upload an image of proof of residency or school attendance in Washington County and age with application. (Proof needs to show address or school with photo: license or school ID.) <p>Eligibility</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Ages 13-20 as of January 31, 2026.• Must be a resident of Washington County, or students who attend a school in Washington County. <p>RESTRICTED REPERTORY</p> <p>Please do not apply with the following repertory. This music was performed last season and therefore will not be accepted:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Pezzo Capriccioso, Op. 62, <i>Pyotr Tchaikovsky</i>• Scottish Fantasy, Op. 46, <i>Max Bruch</i>• Piano Concerto No. 3, Op. 26, first movement, <i>Sergei Prokofiev</i>	<p>First Round</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Submit application and unedited video by January 4, 2026.• Judges from the Beaverton Symphony Orchestra will review all applications.• Applicants will be notified on January 19. Finalists will move to the next round, performing in a recital open to the public. <p>Second Round</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Finalists will perform their submitted piece in the recital, Sunday, February 8, 2026, at the Village Church in Beaverton. 2:00 – 6:00 pm• Piano accompaniment – must be provided on your own.• Judges for the Recital will be from the local performing arts community and will select the top three performers.• The top three will advance as the winners of the competition to later perform with the Beaverton Symphony Orchestra in their season Finale Concerts.	<p>Winners</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The three winners will be coached by Maestro Dr. Pierre-Alain Chevalier at mutually agreeable times before the first orchestra rehearsal to work on performance details.• Each winner will receive a \$1,000 scholarship from the Beaverton Symphony Orchestra.
