- Education. We make presentations in schools to explain the symphony orchestra, and we invite student musicians to perform before our concerts and at intermissions. We are developing educational collaborative relationships with school districts throughout the local area.
- Families and Seniors. We make live classical music performances affordable for the whole family with a \$20 Family Ticket. Seniors enjoy \$5 tickets—especially at Sunday afternoon performances.
- Special Needs Community. We offer free tickets to the special needs community, including residents of homes for developmentally disabled.
