Application Deadline: 11:59 pm, Sunday, February 2, 2025

Three young artists will win a \$1,000 scholarship!

Instructions:

- Completed application must be submitted by 11:59 pm, Sunday, February 2, 2025.
- Include with your application a link to an unedited video of your performance, no more than 12 minutes in length.

The piece may be a part of a larger work (for example, a movement from a multi movement concerto), or it may be a couple of smaller works (for example 2 or 3 selected arias).

 Upload an image of proof of residency or school attendance in Washington County and age with application. (Proof needs to show address or school with photo ID: license, school ID.)

Eligibility:

- Ages 13-20 as of January 31, 2025.
- Must be a resident of Washington County, or students who attend a school in Washington County.

First Round:

- Submit application and unedited video.
- Judges from the Beaverton Symphony Orchestra will review all applications.
- Applicants will be notified on February 14.

Finalists will move to the next round, performing in a recital open to the public.

Second Round:

- Finalists will perform their submitted piece in the recital,
 Sunday, March 9, 2025, at 3:00 pm at the Village Church in Beaverton.
- Piano accompaniment must be provided on your own.
- The Judges for the Recital will be from the performing arts industry and will select the top three performers.
- The top three will advance as the winners of the competition to later perform with the Beaverton Symphony Orchestra in their season Finale Concerts

Winners:

 Three winners will be coached as a group with Maestro Dr. Pierre-Alain Chevalier at mutually agreeable times before the first orchestra rehearsal to work on performance details.

Orchestra Rehearsals:

- Winners must be available at a minimum to rehearse with the BSO on the following dates:
- Thursday, May 1 6:45 9:15pm
- Thursday, May 8 6:45 9:15pm
- Monday, May 12 6:45-9:15 pm
- Thursday, May 15 6:45 -9:15 pm

Concerts:

- Winners will perform with the BSO in two concerts
- Friday May 16, 7:30 pm at the Patricia Reser Center for the Arts
- Sunday May 18, 3:00 pm at Village Church.
